SECTION 4: First aid measures**4.1. Description of first aid measures**

Store in original containers at 8-21°C (46.4-69.8°F) and do not return residual materials to containers as contamination may reduce the shelf life of the bulk product. Store separately from oxidizing agents, strongly alkaline and strongly acidic materials, amines, alcohols and water. Do not store together with explosives, gases, oxidizing solids, products which form flammable gases in contact with water, oxidizing products, infectious products and radioactive products.
